The Junior Academy will be held the following Wednesdays:

• June 5th, 12th, 19th, 26th and July 10th, 17th, 24th, and 31st.

Cost of the Program:

- \$300.00 for 8 sessions
- Multiple Children Discount:
 - \$25.00 off per additional child
 - I.e. 2nd child = \$275.00

Who is eligible and Level of Experience needed?

- Boys and Girls, ages 6-15.
- Previous experience is not necessary.
- Juniors will be assigned to the 6- or 9-hole groups, according to their age, experience and tested skill level.

How many Juniors will be accepted?

• 20 per check- in group, 40 total.

Daily Schedule:

- Juniors arrive either by 8 am or 9 am.
- Check in is immediately and they will be assigned a tee time, name tag, and instruction group assignment.
- Junior will have a 1-hour instruction by PGA certified Golf Professionals.
- Lunch will be provided: Choice of Hamburger, Cheeseburger or Hot dog with chips and a drink.
- Tee times will go as scheduled- 9-hole groups followed by 6-hole groups.
 - Ideally, Juniors will wait no longer than 30 minutes to begin play.
- Play will take no longer than 3 hours.

Scores:

- After completing each round, juniors will be required to turn in his/her scorecard to the pro-shop.
- Recorded scores aid the staff in grouping juniors of the same skill level together.

Mandatory Volunteerism:

- Parents are required to volunteer for (2) dates of the Junior Academy.
 - NOTE: In the event that we lack volunteers on certain days, we reserve the right to assign you to a date that you did not request, and we also reserve the right to assign you a 3rd volunteer date, if necessary.
- Families with multiple children in the program will be responsible for additional volunteer dates.
 - Example:
 - 2 children = 3 volunteer dates
 - 3 children = 4 volunteer dates
- Volunteering will consist of scoring and chaperoning, cart will be provided.
- If you cannot volunteer on your assigned day, it is your responsibility to find a suitable replacement.
- Failure to show or provide a substitute will result in the dismissal of your junior golfer(s) from the program.

Rainouts:

- In the unlikely event that an Academy event is cancelled due to weather, we will issue a "rain check" to each participant for:
 - 6 or 9 holes of golf
 - Lunch
- Rain checks must be redeemed by December 2019.

NOTE: Due to limited time and scheduling during the summer, Academy dates that are cancelled *will not* be rescheduled.

Dress Code:

- Metal Spikes are NOT allowed.
- Tennis shoes or soft spiked shoes will only be allowed.
- Collared shirts are REQUIRED by all participants.
- Skorts, Skirts, Bermuda length shorts, or slacks are allowed.
- Short Skirts are NOT allowed.
- First offense:
 - Verbal Warning.
- Second offense:
 - Dismissal from the program without refund.

Equipment:

- Players are responsible for providing their own equipment
- Pull carts <u>WILL NOT</u> be allowed and will not be available for rental, unless deemed medically necessary.
- Each junior is required to carry his/her own bag.

 Juniors <u>WILL NOT</u> be allowed to ride or place their equipment on the golf carts at <u>ANY</u> time.

Conduct of Players:

- Any misconduct such as cheating, falsification of score, abuse of equipment, use of tobacco or alcohol, gambling, disrespect for the golf course or facility, staff, volunteer, or fellow competitor will not be tolerated and will result in immediate disqualification from the days event and possibly removal from the program.
- Repeat offense will result in suspension from the program without refund of monies.
- In the event of a major infringement of the golf course or fellow competitor takes place, immediate removal from the program will occur and monies will not be refunded.
- The staff and owner of Paradise Valley Golf Club reserve the right to review and decide the severity of each misconduct.

Participant Orientation:

- Only NEW participants are required to attend an orientation.
- A Liability Waiver/Agreement must be sent in with each entry form and payment in order to complete registration.
- Please review and see the Liability agreement section below and attached to the registration form.

Liability Agreement:

- Please sign and return the liability agreement with your entry form and payment.
- As a returning participant, you will NOT be required to attend an orientation.
- A Liability agreement must be signed and submitted for <u>EACH</u> junior golfer in the program to complete registration.

Confirmation:

 A confirmation email will be sent to you once the application, payment, and all other components are received.
